

2020 Revaluation

Connecticut State Statutes require that municipalities perform revaluation no later than 5 years after the last revaluation. The Town of New Milford is working on the Revaluation for the October 1, 2020 Grand List. The last Revaluation was completed with the filing of the October 1, 2015 Grand List.

To comply with Connecticut State Statutes, the current revaluation requires the measuring and inspection of **all** properties. Due to the scope of work required, the Town of New Milford has contracted with Vision Government Solutions to assist with the revaluation. At this time field representatives of Vision Government Solutions are conducting inspections of all properties within New Milford.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the necessity of social distancing, the town has altered the manner in which inspections are conducted. The Vision employee will only be measuring the exterior of the dwelling or building. If the owner is present at that time of their visit, information concerning the interior characteristics will be discussed at the door. If the owner is not present at the time of the visit, a letter will be sent at a later date to provide an opportunity to review the interior information.

All Vision employees have picture identification and their motor vehicles are listed with the New Milford Police Department

The Town of New Milford appreciates your co-operation and assistance in providing Vision personnel with access to your property and the information necessary to complete the project.
