Smoke and carbon monoxide detectors

When alterations or additions requiring a permit occur, or when one or more sleeping rooms are added or created in existing dwelling, the entire dwelling shall be provided with smoke detectors and carbon monoxide located as required for new dwellings. The smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors shall receive there power from the building wiring when such wiring is served from a commercial source, and when primary power is interrupted, they shall receive power from a battery.

Exceptions:

1. The smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors may be battery operated or plug-in and are not required to be interconnected when other remodeling considerations do not require the removal of the appropriate wall and ceiling coverings to facilitate concealed interconnected wiring.
2. Alterations to the exterior surfaces of dwelling including, but not limited to, re-roofing, re-siding, window replacement and the construction of decks without roofs, shall be exempt from the requirements of this section.
3. Carbon monoxide detectors shall not be required in dwelling units not containing a fuel-burning appliance, fireplace or attached garage.
