Call two working days before you dig. Provide the town, street address, type of work, name of caller and company, phone number and start date and time.




Remember that you need a permit to work in the Right of Way.

Do I need to get a highway encroachment permit?


These are only facts. For full details please refer to the permit regulations.


What do I need to do when I resurface my driveway?



Normally, the contractor you hire should make out the application as most of them are bonded with the State.

Should you desire to submit the application, you should enclose a map showing your property and what you intend to do.

(see sample below)



Can I put a sign on State property?

No, not unless you are one of the following groups or organizations:

State, Municipal or Federal Government

Church or ecclesiastical society

Service Organizations

(exception: Entrance and Exit signs conforming to Department standards)

No signs of political or commercial nature shall be placed on the right of way. **All** signs that are illegally placed in the right of way will be removed.
