Dear Neighbor,

As part of our everyday effort to deliver reliable energy and superior customer service, Eversource Energy is scheduled to start transmission work in your area in the next few weeks.

Reliability Improvements in Your Neighborhood

This maintenance work is taking place on the Eversource right-of-way that is on or near your property. Please note that this work will not interrupt electric service to your home or business.

What You Can Expect

Crews from Michels Power and Supreme Industries, working on behalf of Eversource, will be replacing existing wood structures with new steel structures along portions of the 321 and 1618 Lines from Long Mountain Road to Danbury Road in the town of New Milford.

There will be construction vehicles on the rights-of-way, including heavy equipment. Associated work will include site grading, mowing/vegetation removal, graveling the access road, setting of timber mats and replacing existing wood structures with new weathering steel structures of similar size. Upon project completion, crews will restore areas disturbed by work.

Work hours will be Monday through Sunday 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. This maintenance project is expected to be complete by the end of 2017, though some restoration efforts may occur in early 2018. Please keep in mind the schedule is subject to change due to weather and other unexpected circumstances.

Eversource is also planning to rebuild the existing 1555 Line along part of this same right-of-way corridor. You will be receiving information concerning the 1555 Line rebuild separately.
