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The Town of New Milford's Contractor, Gorman Brother's, will begin Chip Sealing on/or after 9/8/2017 and will continue for approximately 10 days. On these days please drive slowly and allow extra time. Consider the use of alternate routes and expect delays. The schedule is weather permitting, and may be subject to change. Loose Gravel signs will be used to indicate a change in road condition. Chip seal is an effective low cost pavement preservation technique. Loose Stone will be swept 4-5 business days after chip seal application.
