

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

STILL RIVER DRIVE ROUNDABOUT PROJECT

Sealed bids will be received at the Office of the Director of Finance, Town Hall, New Milford, CT, 06776 until the hour of 3 p.m., on February 22, 2018. Bids must be enclosed in a sealed envelope, addressed to the Purchasing Authority, Town of New Milford, 10 Main Street, New Milford, CT 06776, and **clearly marked: Still River Drive Roundabout**

Work includes construction of a roundabout. This will include curbing, drainage work, excavation and fill to proposed grades, a mill and pave for the remainder of Still River Drive from Danbury Road to Still River Drive Bridge and other associated road work per plans and specifications.

Electronic bid documents will be available for download only at <https://www.tighebond.com/projects-out-to-bid/> Bidders must print and submit proposals on the forms provided and in a sealed envelope, plainly marked with the appropriate title.

Bid security payable to the Town of New Milford in the form of a bid bond only is required for 5% of the base bid proposal, issued by an acceptable surety on AIA Document A310 or comparable legal bond form, and must accompany each bid.

The successful bidder must post a 100% Performance Bond and a 100% Labor & Materials Bond on notice of contract award in the form of an AIA Document A311 or comparable legal bond form. The cost of these bonds must be included in the bid price.

Contractors must carry minimum insurance coverage limits, as indicated in the bid specifications. A certificate of insurance must accompany all bids. Attention to bidders is directed to certain requirements of this contract which require payment of the State of Connecticut Prevailing Wage Rates.

The contractor who is selected to perform this project must comply with CONN. GEN. STAT. §§ 4a-60, 4a-60a, 4a-60g, and 46a-68b through 46a-68f, inclusive, as amended by June 2015 Special Session Public Act 15-5. State law requires a minimum of twenty-five (25%) percent of the state-funded portion of the contract be set-aside for award to subcontractors holding current certification from the Connecticut Department of Administrative Services ("DAS") under the provisions of CONN. GEN. STAT. § 4a-60g, as amended. (25% of the work with DAS certified Small and Minority owned businesses and 25% of that work with DAS certified Minority, Women and/or Disabled owned businesses.) The contractor must demonstrate good faith effort to meet the 25% set-aside goals.

Any bidder found by the Purchasing Authority to be delinquent in the payment of taxes and/or sewer use charge due to the Town of New Milford, for either personal or real property, shall abide by the regulations as set forth in the Purchase Ordinance (as amended 08.09.93) Sec. 2.92 Bids. Copies of which may be obtained at the Finance Office, Town Hall.

In addition to the bid specifications, all bids are subject to the terms, provisions and conditions of the New Milford "Municipal Purchases" Ordinance, set forth in Article III, Section 2-92 (a) thru (o) inclusive, of the code of New Milford, by bidding on the proposed purchase, the bidder agrees to such terms, provisions and conditions.

The Town of New Milford reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids or any part thereof; to waive any informality, or to accept any bid deemed to be in the best interest of the Town of New Milford. All bids will be considered valid for a period of forty-five (45) days.
